The City of Saco seeking Solutions For Route 112 Traffic Congestion

The City of Biddeford would like to make you aware that the City of Saco is conducting a traffic study of the Route 112/exit 36 area. The City of Saco will hold a public meeting and listening session on June 14 at Saco City Hall Auditorium, 300 Main Street, from 6:00-7:30 pm to explore and evaluate potential solutions to the morning and evening congestion occurring on Route 112 and surrounding roads. The City of Saco would like to hear from those who live or travel through the Rt. 112 corridor/exit 36 area on a regular basis. At the meeting, a schedule, map and the criteria that will guide the final decision-making process will also be available. This study is scheduled to be completed in early 2019.
