

Holiday Trash Collection Schedule

THANKSGIVING DAY

There will be **NO** trash or recycling pick up on Thursday, November 23, 2017. Trash and recycling normally picked up on this day will be picked up on Friday, November 24, 2017 instead.

The Recycling/Transfer Station will be closed Thursday and Friday as well, however it will be open Saturday and Sunday 7:00am-2:45pm.

REMINDER:

Sunday, November 26th will be the last Sunday the Transfer Station will be open.

Monday, November 27th is last day for curbside leaf collection for Wards 5, 6 & 7

CHRISTMAS DAY & NEW YEAR'S DAY

There will be **NO** trash and recycling pick up Monday, December 25, 2017 and Monday, January 1, 2018

REMINDER TO RESIDENTS OF BIDDEFORD REGARDING TRASH COLLECTION FOLLOWING THE THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY

In accordance with the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 58, Sec. 58-34 (a), **residents are exempt from the separation and overflow requirements for the trash and recycling collection period immediately following the Thanksgiving Holiday.** Therefore, on the following trash collection days there is no requirement to use the City's orange Pay As You Throw (PAYT) bags for any overflow trash:

Friday, November 24
Monday, November 27
Tuesday, November 28
Wednesday, November 29
Thursday, November 30

Beginning on Friday, December 1st, the requirements related to separation and overflow are back in effect so the use of the City's orange Pay As You Throw (PAYT) bags will again be required for all overflow trash.
